Generic Amendment IBFMPs: Buoy Gear Definition and Use	<ul><li>Submitted by CFMC on Nov 2, 2022</li><li>Next stage: draft of proposed rule</li></ul>	Prohibits buoy gear use for recreational sector; Allows up to 25 hooks on buoy gear for commercial fishers.
eneric Amendment IBFMPs: Trawl, Net Gear, and Descending Devices	- Draft of Chapters 1 and 2 for CFMC to select preferred alternatives at Dec 2022 meeting.	May prohibit use of all trawl gear in EEZ or MMAs; may prohibit use of gillnets, trammel nets, purse seines in EEZ; may require use of descending devices when fishing for reef fish in EEZ.
